

Scrappy Door Draft Stop Sleeve



Using scrap 1" strips, sew into strata's using strips as small as 1" x 12". Cross cut strata's into 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sections. Then sew each sections together to achieve approx. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40" in length. Press all seams in the same direction.



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Fold RST(right sides together) stitch $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance on the long seam. Using a template (cd) to achieve a curve. Draw a curve on one end. Stitch on the line and trim $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam away from seam.



On opposite end of sleeve, turn one strip in and topstitch to wrong side of fabric.



Slide the sleeve over your arm, grab the draft stopper insert from inside the sleeve. Gently get the insert to slide inside your sleeve. It is a bit of a challenge in the beginning, but it slides easier as you get it moving.



Continue to slide the insert pulling until the end pokes through, now it will be easy to pull right side out and slide sleeve over the insert.





Once it is right side out. The fabric sleeve will extend over the draft stopper. Turn the excess inside and top stitch the edge. Which will give a nice finish inside . You are now finished your scrappy strip draft stopper.





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
