

ABUNDANCE

96.5" X 96.5"

Sew this pattern using a scant ¼" seam allowance.

WOF = width of fabric, RST = right sides together, HST = half square triangle

'Companion Angle ruler' option for HST.

Step 1: SISTER'S CHOICE BLOCK. Make 9 blocks. 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished blocks.

This block uses Fabrics # 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Cutting instructions:

Note: When cutting HST only choose one option.

Fabric #1 Cut 2 - 2 1/4" Strips WOF. Sub-cut into 36 - 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares. Label 'A'.

HST option 1: Cut 3 - 25/8" strips WOF. Sub-cut into 36 - 25/8" x 25/8" squares. Label 'B'.

HST option 2: 'Companion Angle' Cut 5 -2" strips WOF.

Fabric #2 Cut 4 – 2 ¼" strips WOF. Sub-cut into 36 – 2 ¼" x 4" rectangles. Label 'D'.

Fabric #3 Cut 1 - 2 1/4" strip WOF. Sub-cut into 9 - 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares. Label 'E'.

HST option 1: Cut 3 - 25/8" strips WOF. Sub-cut into 36 - 25/8" x 25/8" squares. Label 'B'.

HST option 2: 'Companion Angle' Cut 5 - 2" strips WOF.

Fabric #4 Cut 2 - 2 1/4" strips WOF. Sub-cut into 36-2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares. Label 'C'.

Block construction:

HST construction use fabric #1 and fabric #3.

Option 1: Draw a diagonal line on the back of all Fabric #1 - 25/8" squares.

Pair RST with Fabric #3-25/8" squares. Sew %" seam on both sides of the diagonal line.

Cut on the drawn diagonal line and make 2 HST. Press to dark fabric, repeat until you have


72 HST. Trim to 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" HST. Label 'B'.

Option 2: 'Companion Angle ruler' method.

Pair up Fabric #1 and Fabric #3 WOF strips. Sew ¼" seams on both sides of the strips.

Using 'Companion Angle ruler' place

on the strip and cut HST, 18 per strip.



Press towards the dark fabric, repeat until you have 72 HST. Trim to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" HST. Label 'B'.

Place one piece 'A', 2 HST 'B' and one Piece 'C'.

Stitch together as per diagram.

Press towards solid squares 'A' and 'C'.

Make 4 of these units per block. 36 units in total.

Measuring 4" x 4".

Use diagram for placement of block.

Sew in rows.

Row 1.





Row 3.

Press in directions of the arrows.

Make 9 blocks.

9 ½" x 9 ½ "unfinished.
